You must fill out the attached form and make it available to the appropriate individuals. Put the forms in a Ziploc bag and keep it with your first aid kits - hoping you never need it.

It is also good to have insurance information in case you need to go to the emergency room. The hospital will always want parent approval before treatment. However, most people do not think to grab their insurance information when they attend games or as they run out the door after a phone call telling them their child has been hurt.

Please appoint a staff member to complete this Information prior to your first practice. No player may practice or play until all physician release forms, player emergency information forms and parents release forms are completed and in your possession.
