Fee assessed, if not paid your Matches will be forfeited.

## Official's Fees:

- Single Match: \$50
- Double Match: \$80
- Tri-Match: $\$ 115$


## Official's Fees:

- Splitting a double match or tri-match into a single match will result in the fee being \$55 for each match


## Official's Fees:

- Cancelling a match within 48 hours will result in the cancelling team to pay the full amount for the official to the league. (pay to the order of Pittsburgh Diocesan Boys Volleyball)
- If the cancelling team does not pay the fee the team will not be allowed to participate in playoffs and/or be able to have teams next season.


## Tournaments

- If you/your school is interested in hosting a tournament please contact me about scheduling officials


## Clearances

- All coaches must have:
- Act 34 clearance
- Act 151 clearance
- Attend Protecting God's children workshop


## Who can play?

- Boys in $4^{\text {th }}$ grade through $8^{\text {th }}$ grade
- Cannot be older than 14 years old
- Can play 4 years from the $5^{\text {th }}$ grade through the $8^{\text {th }}$ grade.
- No $3^{\text {rd }}$ graders and no girls
- $4^{\text {th }}$ graders are not allowed to play in a varsity match


## Setting up your teams:

1. Designate a team color (e.g. Green, White, Red, etc.)

- If you have multiple teams they must have different colors

2. If your school has multiple JVs make sure to align the JV and Varsity teams colors that you want scheduled together.

- Players are able to be rostered under one JV and one Varsity team only, they do not have to be on the same color.


## Calendar

- The calendar (which can be found on the website) must be filled out with available home play dates. (do not include black out dates).
- There will be no matches played 3/284/1, 2024 for Easter break


## Scheduling of Matches:

- There are 7 weeks of play dates for regular season matches
- Each team gets $\mathbf{3}$ black out dates which are dates that you cannot play home or away
- Plus include up to 3 preferred not to play dates which we will try to accommodate


## Scheduling of Matches:

Please provide as many home play dates as possible,
including Sunday's, Monday's, Wednesday's and
Friday's.
Tuesday and Thursday evenings are going to be one
or two matches max, because of high school games
and lack of referees.

## Scheduling of Matches:

- You cannot dictate which team plays on which day
- If the gym is open I will choose which team will be playing


## Scheduling of Matches:

- If your school has an weekly event, such as bingo, that runs until 6:00 pm (the start time for a match). Please do not use that day as a home play date
- You need to provide more than one day a week that you can play in your gym


## Cancelling Matches:

- Once the schedule is set...

If you cancel a match you must:

1. Let your section coordinator know and the head coach from all the other team(s) (JV/Varsity coaches).
2. Find a new date that works for all teams
3. When a new date is set, let your section coordinator know and I will assign you an official (no more than 1 week after the cancelled match)

## Cancelling of Matches:

- No scheduled games may be cancelled due to illness within the team
- The only exception is if the entire school is closed due to a widespread illness
- No scheduled games will be cancelled for other sports
- We do not use the cancellation form that is listed on 2badcats.


## Cancelling of Matches:

- If your team cancels a match within 48 hours of the scheduled start time you will:
- Forfeit the match
- Have to pay the league (who will pay the official) the full official fee
- If you do not pay the fee before the end of the season you will forfeit your playoff spot


## Play times:

- Weekday matches:
- Start at 6:30 pm or 7:00 pm
- Varsity match will be played as soon as JV match is done
- Weekend Matches:
- Not before 5:00 pm on Saturday or 1:00 pm on Sundays


## Play times/court:

- Home team must open gym no later than 45 minutes before start of first match.
- At this time:
- The net should be set up to play
- Court should be ready to play


## Home Team

- Will be responsible for :
- Keeping a score book for both JV and Varsity matches
- Scheduling and supplying trained line judges
- The referee will ensure that the line judges know what their responsibilities are.


## Scrimmages:

- There is no set amount of how many scrimmages are allowed to be played
- You do not have to inform me about scrimmages, unless you would like an official, then I can schedule one for you


## 4 rules to review:

1. Foot fault
2. Back row attack
3. Attacking/Blocking a served ball
4. No Jewlery

## Start of Season/Playoffs:

- Season will start Sunday March 24
- 8 teams will make the playoffs for both JV and Varsity
- Championship will be Either Saturday May 18 or Sunday May 19
- We will continue to play games up until May 12


## IMPORTANT DATES

Anytime you can get gym time - First Practice Date
February 16-Home Date Availability and Data Sheets (3 blackout dates and 3 prefer not to play dates)

March 24 - Rosters and First matches could be scheduled
April 5 - Fees due. If not received there will be a $\$ 25$ assessed fee. If not paid, games will be forfeited until paid.

May 13 - Playoffs begin
May 18 or 19 - Semifinals, Consolation and Championships JV and Varsity
