**Discount Options**

1. **Register your school team:** When five or more players from any school team are registered for the same week of camp; each camper will receive \$30 off of the original price.
2. **Register by May 20<sup>th</sup>:** When application (along with payment) is mailed by May 10<sup>th</sup> (must be postmarked by this day) campers will receive \$30 off of the original price.
3. **Register the family:** When two or more kids are registered within the same family, the first camper will receive \$30 off of the original price, \$50 off for the second, and \$70 off for each additional child's camp entry fee.
4. **Register for more than 1 camp:** When a camper is registered for more than one camp, they will receive \$30 off of the original price, then \$50 off of any additional camp.
